THE CRITERIA FOR BOTH AWARDS ARE THE SAME

1. Please complete the appropriate enclosed nomination form and return it with your entry. If nominating your DVS/Volunteer Coordinator/Volunteer Liaison and your CEO/Administrator for these awards, two separate nomination articles and entry forms must be submitted.
2. Write an ARTICLE – **NO LONGER THAN ONE TYPED PAGE** – placing special emphasis on the following criteria with specific examples when possible.
 - a. In what ways do they encourage communication and teamwork within the Volunteer Services department and the hospital.
 - b. In what ways do they make the volunteers aware of the hospital goals and keep them abreast of the change.
 - c. In what ways do they make themselves accessible to the volunteer membership.
 - d. In what ways do they support the volunteer service members and its goals and encourage the volunteer governing board to administer the organization.
 - e. In what ways have they proved to be a leader and motivator and have shown adaptability to change.

For the **Community of Conscience Award**, attach a description of your project, giving specific details of how the project came together. This description should **BE TYPED AND NO MORE THAN ONE PAGE**. It should not be a project that you have submitted previously.

Category parameters are as follows: Small – 1-50 beds, Mid-Size – 51-199 beds, Large – 200+ beds.
