Please be sure to read and understand all instructions and policies of the Scholarship Selection Committee before distributing the application forms. Make sure that all required information is included with the application. Reference letters should be from teachers or counselors whenever possible, and all applicants must be sponsored by Volunteer Group that is a member of the Council on Volunteer Services Georgia Healthcare.

The Scholarship Selection Committee requires that each applicant has a personal interview with the volunteer scholarship representative.

Each Volunteer Service will submit no more than three (3) applicants from those who apply for the scholarship. You must include an individual letter sponsoring each applicant; it must be typed on hospital or Volunteer Service letterhead and include the current date and signature.
